BofA eyes Charlotte park for 2,000 workers

Plans for University-area development include offices, shops

Bank of America Corp. confirms it plans to develop a 24-acre University-area site as a satellite campus. And the company says more than 2,000 workers could eventually be based there.

Buildout of the corporate office park at Mallard Creek Church Road and North Tryon Street could take five years or longer, depending on the strength of the economy. But **BofA hopes to start the first phase in the near future**, a representative told City Council this week.

That first phase calls for construction of a 200,000-square-foot signature building that could be up to 200 feet in height. A second phase would add a building 265 feet tall.

BofA disclosed its forecast for employment at the office park in a filing with the city.
