# Lowes to open new Durham store; add 175 jobs

Lowes will open one of its home improvement stores in south Durham by early August, adding 175 jobs to the area.

Construction of the 117,000-square-foot facility at the intersection of Fayetteville Road and Martin Luther King Parkway is largely complete. All that remains is for it to be stocked and employees hired. The company will soon post openings on its Web site, says spokeswoman Maureen Rich.

While no official opening date has been set, Rich says the store should be open by early August. The south Durham location will give the Mooresville, N.C.-based company 20 stores in the Triangle.
