Old Vineyard Behavioral Health Services gets OK for expansion

State regulators have approved a \$14 million expansion project for the Triad's second-largest mental health provider.

Old Vineyard Behavioral Health Services has received conditional approval from the N.C. Division of Health Service Regulation to build a 48,000-square-foot, two-story addition on its campus between Interstate 40 and Country Club Road in southwestern Winston-Salem.

The new building will accommodate 50 mental-health hospital beds to be moved to Old Vineyard from **Broughton Hospital**, a state-owned facility in Morganton, which was not using the beds.

The expansion, which will likely be completed in 2011, will add 73 full-time jobs.
